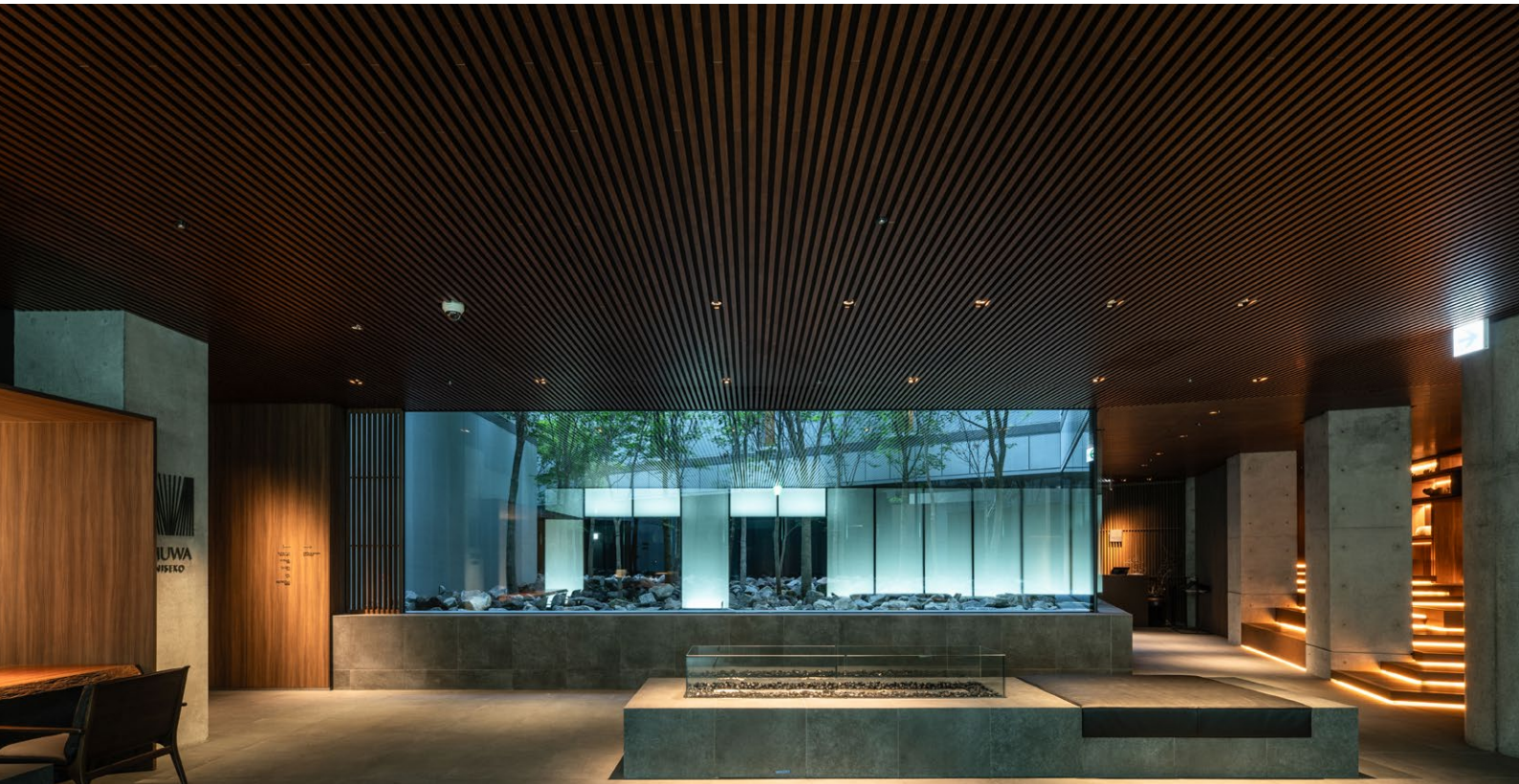


MUWA NISEKO

The art direction was to maximize the modern, ambient atmosphere by incorporating the nature and culture of Hokkaido which includes majestic Mt. Yotei that stands in front of the view. Harmonizing with a unique architecture that incorporates Japanese elements.





B1F Entrance Lobby

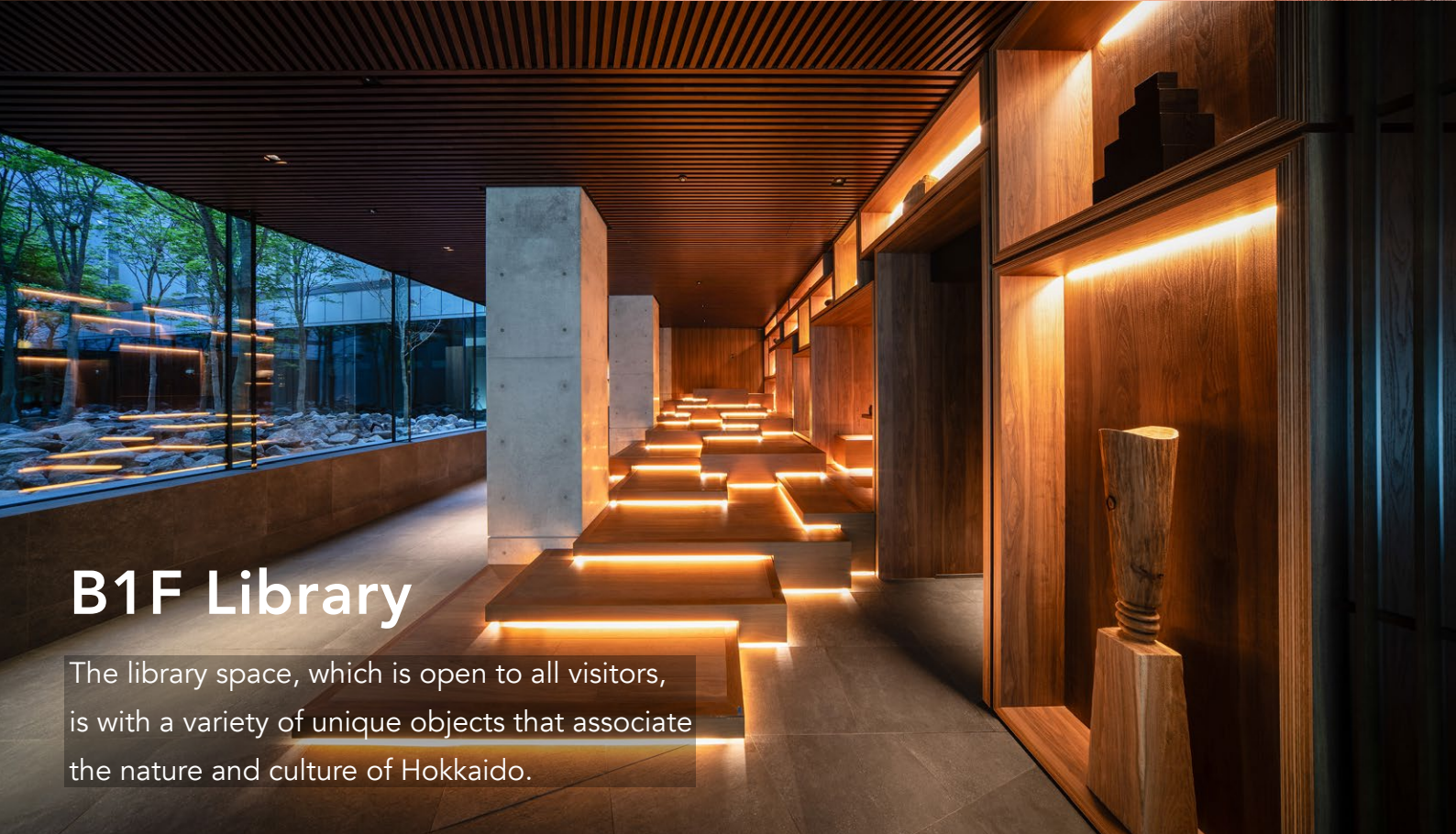
A symbolic jet-black object sits in the elegant and quiet entrance space. This modern yet Japanese-styled vase is for the fresh flowers to welcome guests which draw colours in the ambient space with a view of the courtyard that changes over a year.





B1F VIP

The artwork remains the original shape of the wood as a base. We express the waxing and waning of the moon using the traditional Japanese technique of gold and silver leaf. Pairs of large and small wall-art influence a special touch to the space for VIPs.



B1F Library

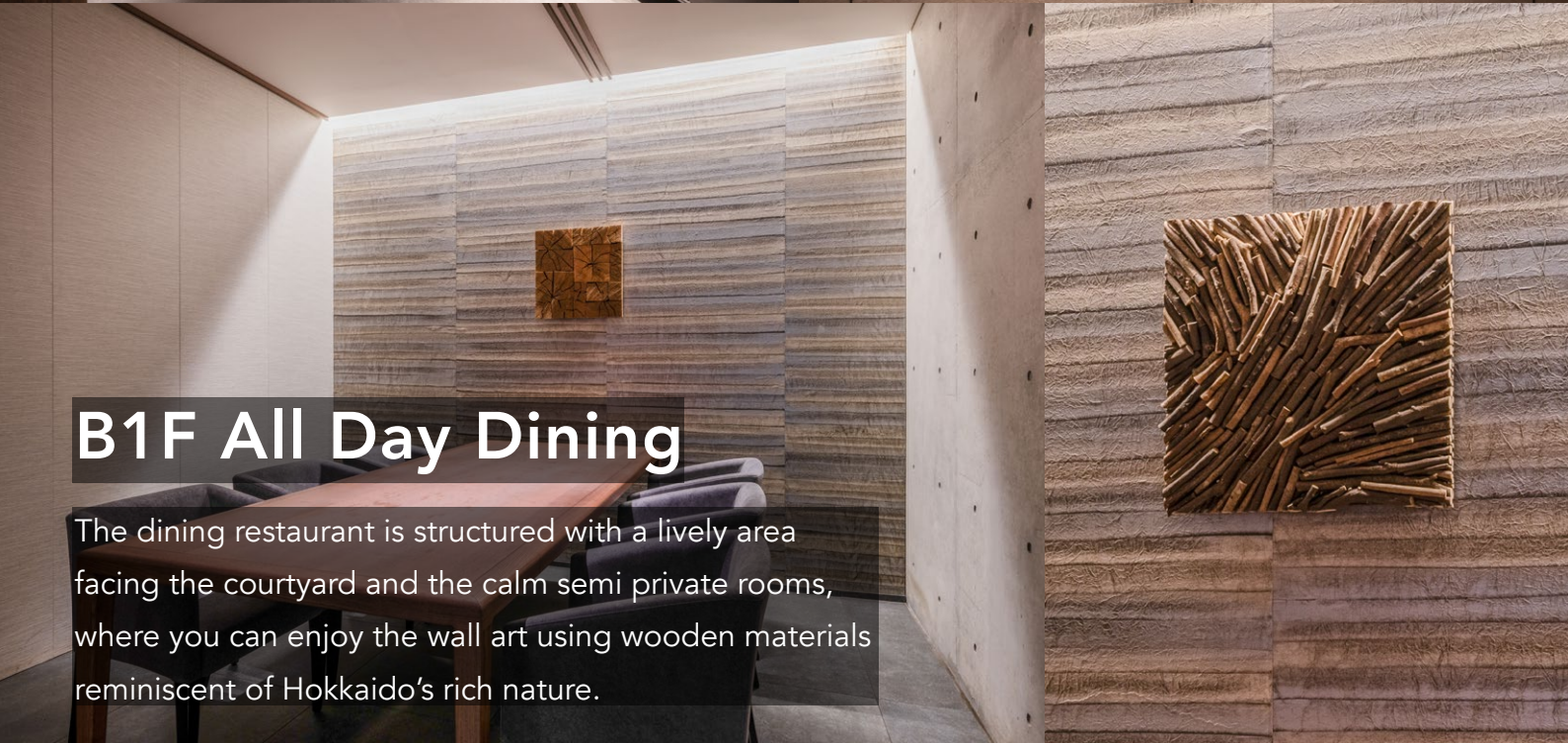
The library space, which is open to all visitors, is with a variety of unique objects that associate the nature and culture of Hokkaido.
