

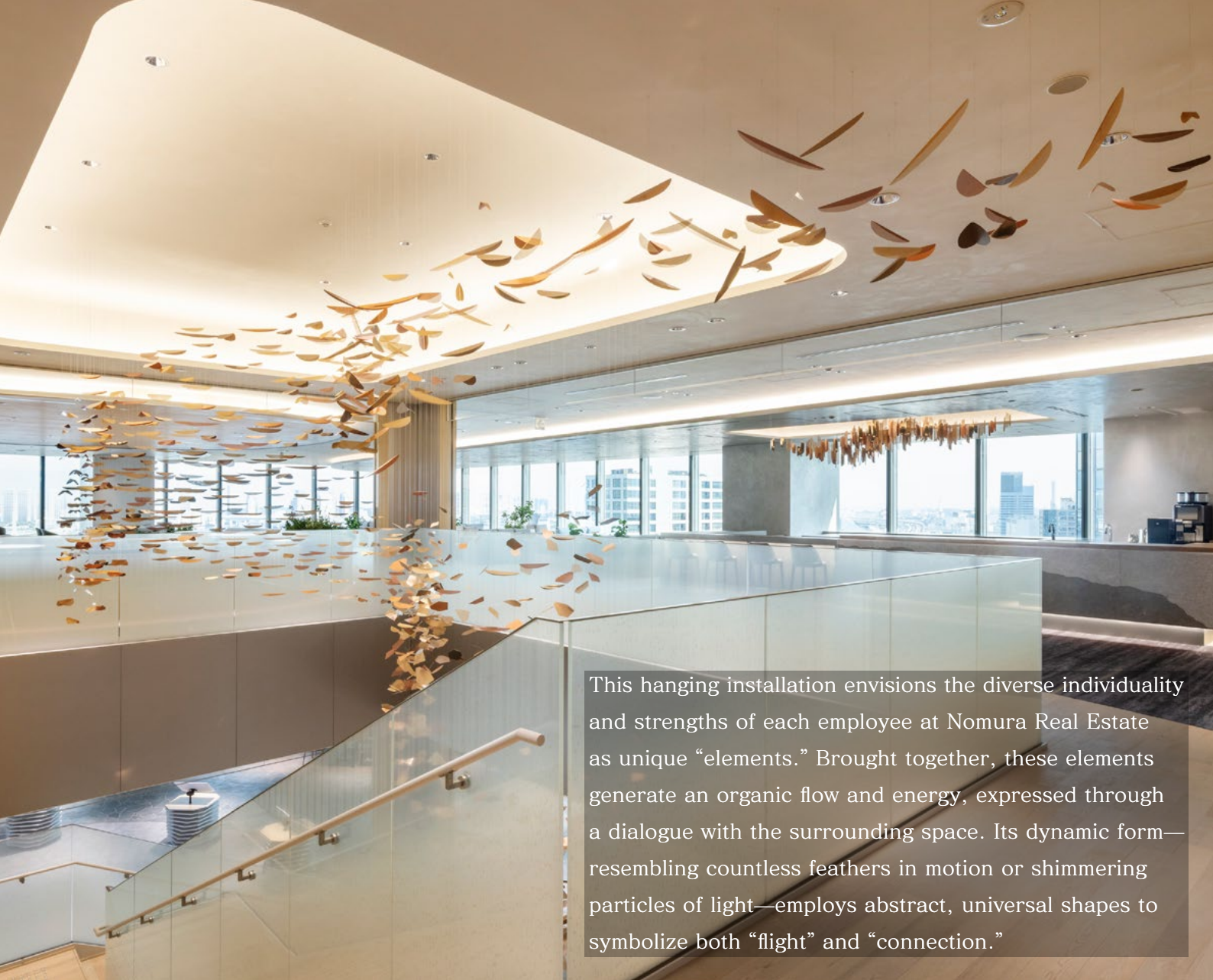

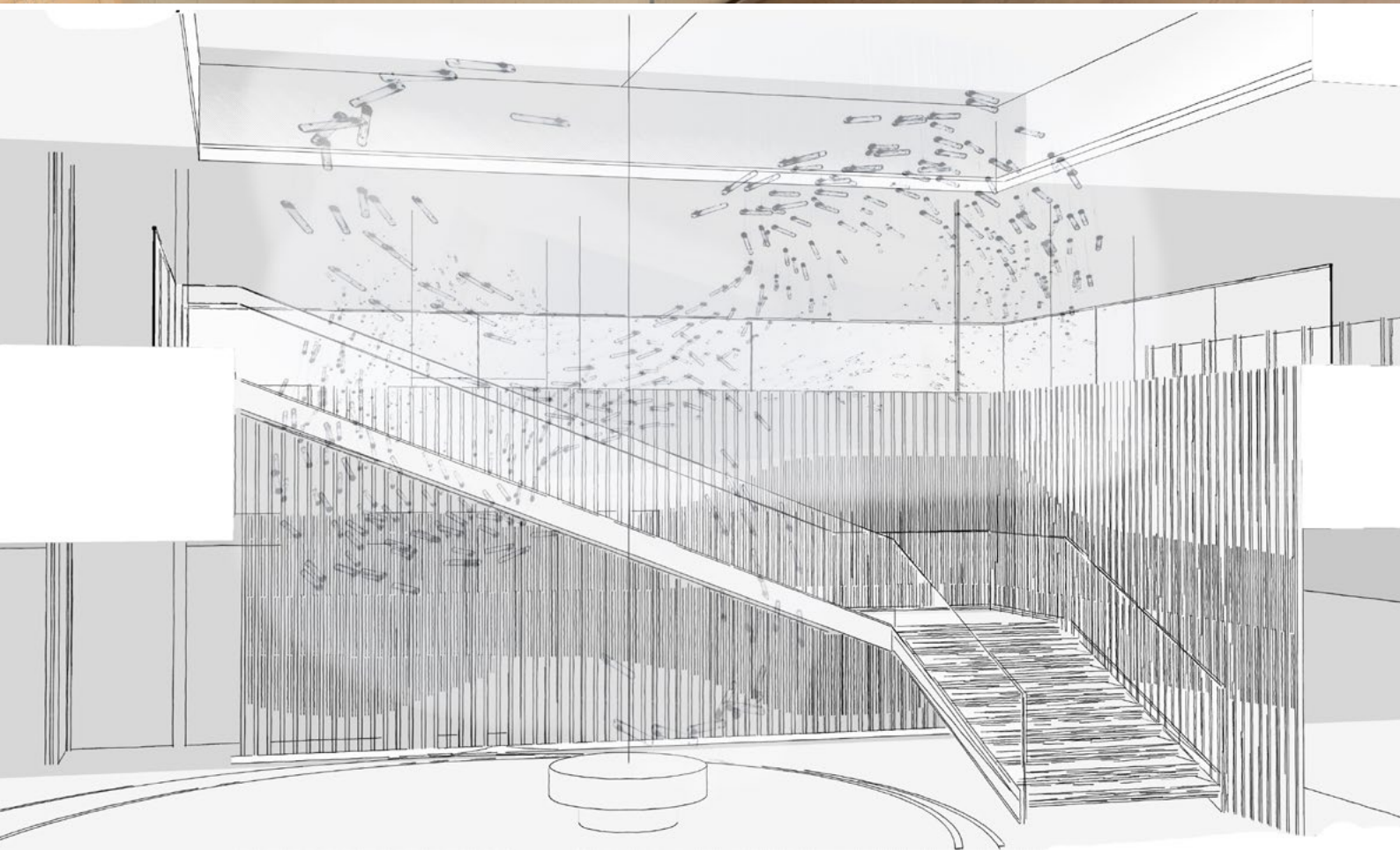


GREAT JOURNEY

Its dynamic form—resembling countless feathers in motion or shimmering particles of light—employs abstract, universal shapes to symbolize both “flight” and “connection.”



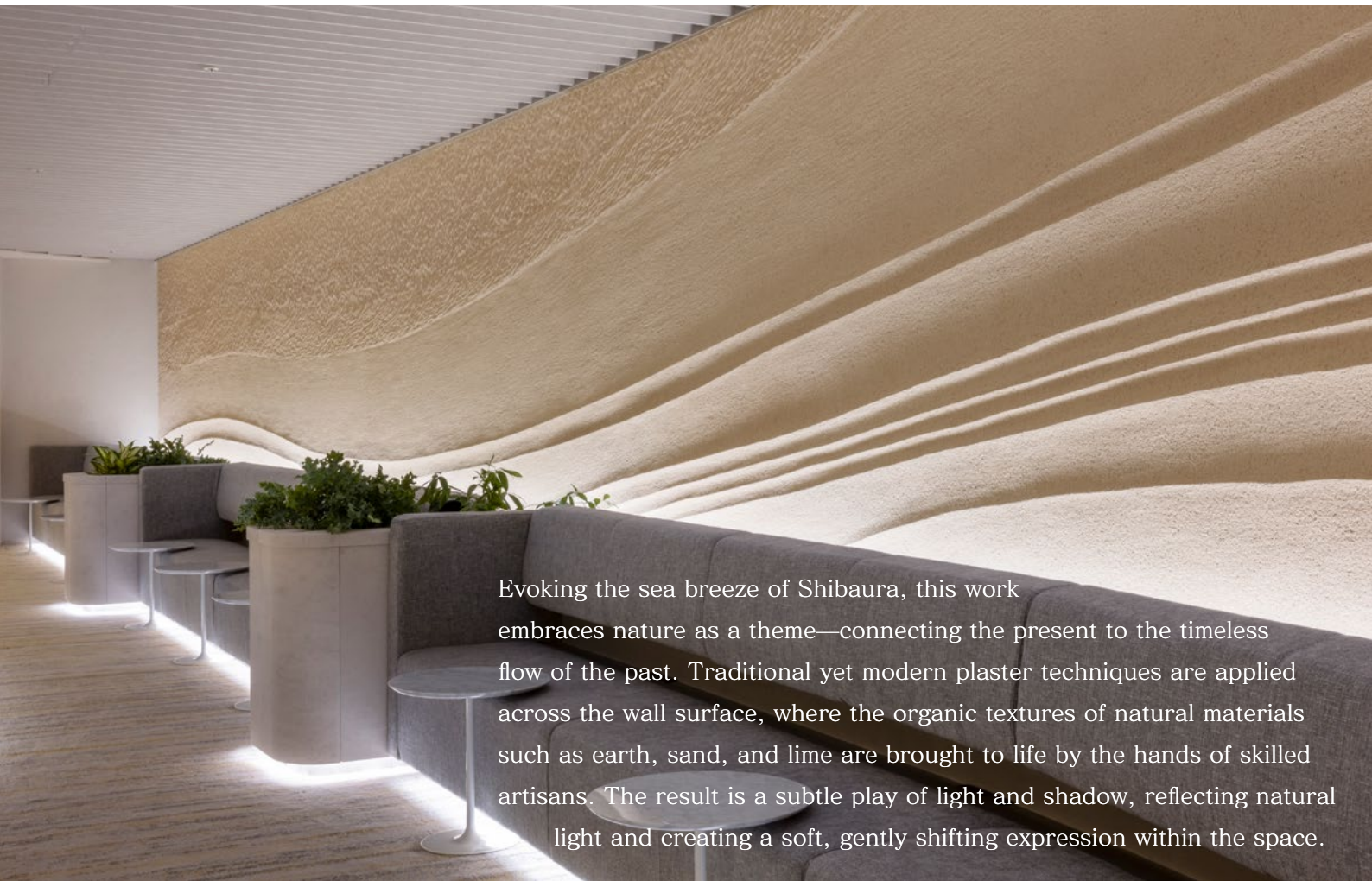


Shaped around the theme of “eternity,” this sculpture presents a subdued golden “LOOP—an infinite circle”. Created by heating and softening copper strips, twisting them, and employing the ancient wazumi coiling technique once used in Jōmon pottery, the artist layered ring-like forms, ultimately joining both ends to complete the circular structure. The work embodies the artist’s wish for “the different” to become the foundation that harmonizes a place.

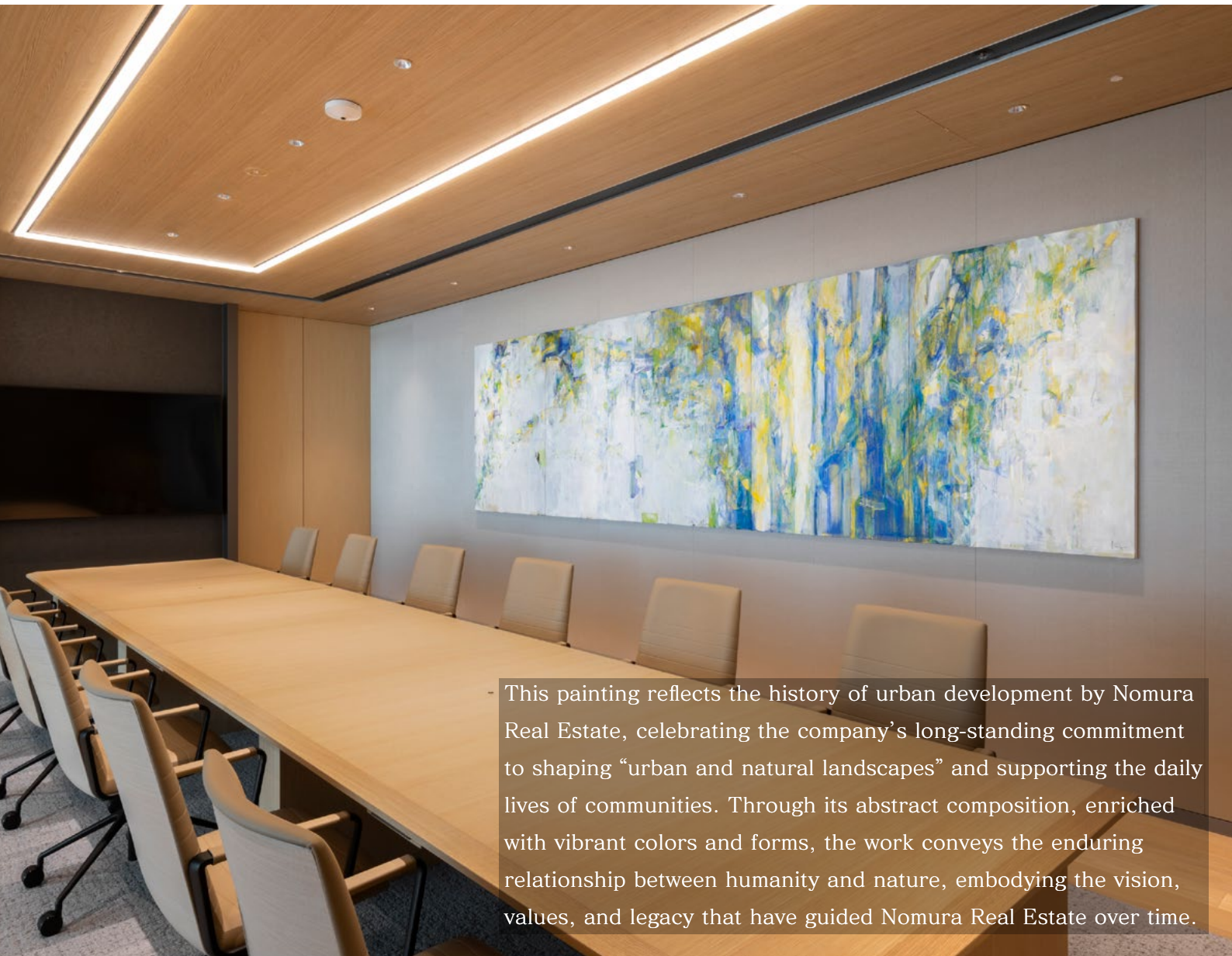




This work, which may be described as a “sculpture floating in midair,” harmonizes with its surroundings while changing expression with the viewer’s gaze and movement. Freed from the pull of gravity, its light presence carries both tension and a sense of suspension, gently speaking to those who encounter it. Inspired by the image of “wind born from an updraft,” the piece evokes the comfort of feeling a breeze beneath the shade of trees. Its flowing lines are composed with a keen awareness of light and the movement of the eye.



Evoking the sea breeze of Shibaura, this work embraces nature as a theme—connecting the present to the timeless flow of the past. Traditional yet modern plaster techniques are applied across the wall surface, where the organic textures of natural materials such as earth, sand, and lime are brought to life by the hands of skilled artisans. The result is a subtle play of light and shadow, reflecting natural light and creating a soft, gently shifting expression within the space.

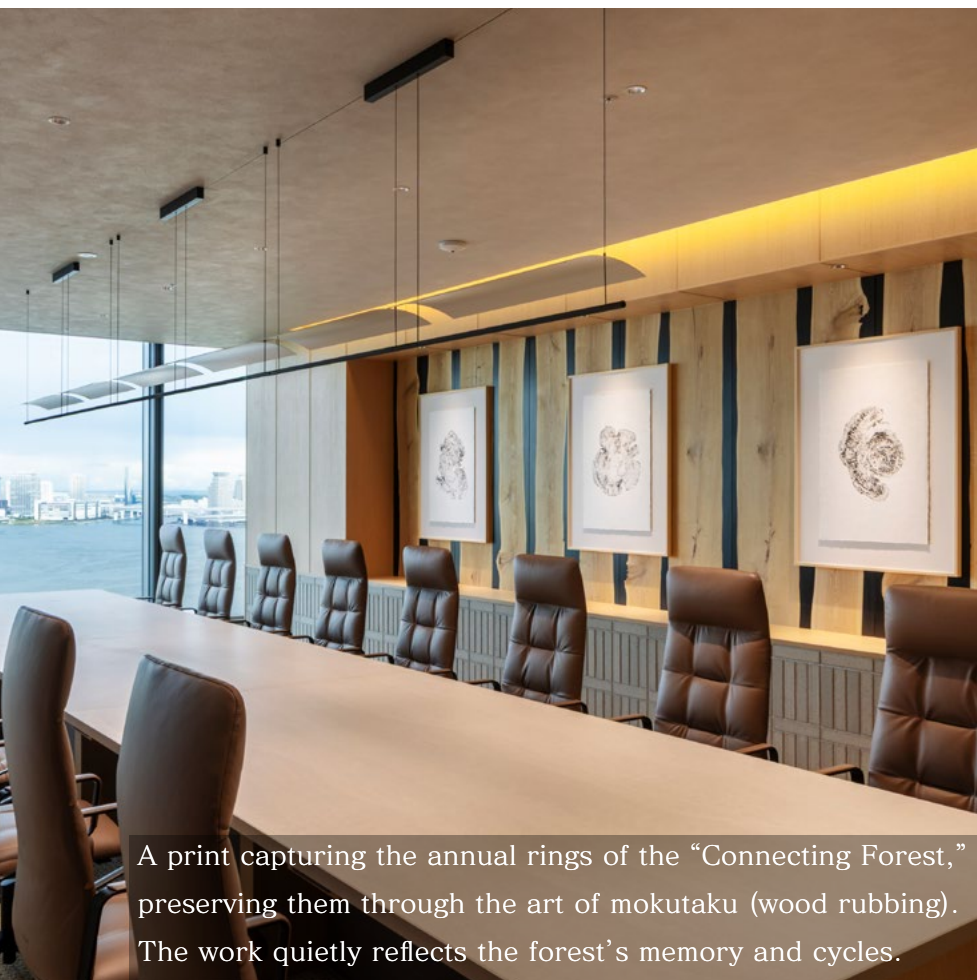


This painting reflects the history of urban development by Nomura Real Estate, celebrating the company's long-standing commitment to shaping "urban and natural landscapes" and supporting the daily lives of communities. Through its abstract composition, enriched with vibrant colors and forms, the work conveys the enduring relationship between humanity and nature, embodying the vision, values, and legacy that have guided Nomura Real Estate over time.



Mori wo Tsunagu TOKYO Project

This project by the Nomura Real Estate Group engages with Tokyo's natural and urban landscapes to foster circulating forest development, biodiversity, and the cultivation of future leaders, contributing to the creation of a sustainable society.

This art project incorporates timber sourced from the Okutama forests owned by the Nomura Real Estate Group, engaging in a process that spans careful selection, milling, and craftsmanship.

This artwork was inspired by the concept of the “Connecting Forest,” embodying the philosophy of linking tree to tree and person to person. Using timber grown in the forest itself, the diagonally cut blocks reveal tree rings in different directions, overlapping to create a unique expression. Through this interplay of time, memory, and perspective, the piece symbolically represents a moment of connection and dialogue nurtured by the forest, reflecting Nomura Real Estate Group's commitment to fostering relationships between nature and communities.





This artwork is created from reclaimed materials used during the building's construction. Hidden structural steel, pipes, valves, and interior substrates—usually unseen—are brought to light, revealing the functional beauty and memories embedded in the architecture.
